Framed, canvas or metal images may not exceed 30 inches on the long side and must hang from a wire on the back. For framed images the preferred format is in black with white or off-white matting. Please label the back of your image with your name.

**April 8, 2020 6:30pm** Opening Reception and awards presentation.

Opening reception will be at the Edward King House, following the opening the Guild will present "There and back again" by Serena Charlebois
